

Miguel González Mendoza held Master and Doctorate studies in Artificial Intelligence from the Institut National des Sciences Appliquées (INSA) in Toulouse, France, in 2000 and 2004 respectively. From 2001 to 2004 he was the responsible and representative of the Laboratory for Analysis and Architecture of Systems (LAAS-CNRS), in Toulouse, France, during its participation in the European research project AWAKE and the French research project PREDIT, as research assistant, then as post-doctorate. His research activities are focused on Machine Learning, Human-Machine interaction; areas in which Dr. Gonzalez Mendoza has supervised 5 PhD Theses, 18 MSc. Theses, Author of 2 books, editor of 12 books, author of 15 book chapters, 23 Journals JCR indexed and 35 research papers in international congresses. Since 2005, he works as professor-researcher, he is the responsible of the Intelligent Systems Research group, and he is the head of the Graduate Programs on Computer Sciences and Information Technologies at the ITESM Campus Estado de Mexico, Mexico. Dr. González Mendoza leads several Mexican (CONACYT, SE) and European Community research projects (as local chair), is secretary of the board of the Mexican Society on Artificial Intelligence, and is member of the Mexican National System of Researchers (SNI), level I. Dr. González Mendoza was invited as "Young Scientist" at the "World Economic Forum for New Champions" in Tianjin China in September 2012.=
